

Advanced Learning Loans

What are advanced learner loans?

These government loans help students like you aged 19 or above pay the fees charged by providers for approved courses between level three and level six.

The loans mean you will not pay any money for your course upfront. Getting a loan doesn't depend on your household income and there's no credit check

When do I repay my learner loan?

Repayments start the April following the completion of your course. You pay back your loan when you finish your course and earn more than £21,000 a year. Your repayments will stop if your income drops below £21,000 a year. Your annual repayment amount will be 9% of any income you earn over £21,000.

For example, your monthly repayments would be:

- £7.50 a month – if you earned £22,000 a year
- £30 a month – if you earned £25,000 a year

How do I apply for an advanced learner loan

Contact us to check that the level 3 or 4 course you are interested in qualifies for the loan. Next ask us for a 'learning and funding information' letter – you need this to complete the application. It contains the details about your course. You can call us on 01268 207651 or email info@beautyskillsacademy.co.uk
